

MCM/ICM: Registration Walk Through

NOTE: This article accompanies, but does not replace the official Rules, Registration, and Instructions found at the contest website (www.mcmcontest.com). Please ensure you understand and follow the rules and procedures outlined on the contest website.

Introduction. The purpose of this article is to assist and guide advisors participating in **The Mathematical Contest in Modeling (MCM)[®]** and **The Interdisciplinary Contest in Modeling (ICM)[®]**. In the article, COMAP provides information about the contest registration process.

COMAP'S **The Mathematical Contest in Modeling (MCM)[®]** and **The Interdisciplinary Contest in Modeling (ICM)[®]** are international contests designed to provide high school and undergraduate students with the opportunity to work as team members to engage and improve their modeling, problem solving, and writing skills.

Teams apply mathematics to model and develop a solution to a real-world problem. Each team can have up to three students and there is no limit on the number of teams a school can register for each contest. Some teachers use the contest as part of a mathematics or modeling course, some as an extracurricular math club activity, and some simply encourage student teams to participate just for fun. Please share this information with all mathematics teachers, as well as other educators (science, technology, engineering, etc.).

Team Members: A team may consist of up to three (3) students currently enrolled in the same school. Students may be enrolled in any department or program at the school. There is no limit to the number of teams a school may register. The contest is open to all undergraduate and high school students. An advisor must complete the registration process for each team.

Advisor. Any faculty, staff member, or student at the team's institution can fulfill the role of Advisor. The advisor will act as the main point of contact for the team and does not have to be from the mathematics department. We encourage faculty members to serve as team advisors; however, one team member or another student at the school may act as the advisor.

Registration. The MCM/ICM registration process has been streamlined and split into 2 parts Advisor Registration and Team Registration (\$100 per team). Any advisor who wishes to sponsor teams in the MCM/ICM contest must register via online system no later than 3pm EST on the day of the contest.

We accept payment via Credit Card, and payment must be made via our secure web site. We regret that we are not able to accept other payment forms.

PART 1: Advisor Registration

The first step is to create an MCM/ICM Advisor account. Enter your email address into the box and click Continue Registration.

The MCM/ICM registration process has been streamlined and split in to 2 parts **Advisor Registration** and **Team Registration (\$100 per team)**. Any advisor who wishes to sponsor teams in the 2024 MCM/ICM contest must register via this online system no later than 3pm EST on Thursday, February 1, 2024.

If you are a team advisor and you have not previously registered for this year's MCM/ICM (registration in previous years does not count), enter your email address in the box below and click on the **Continue Advisor Registration** button.

If you are a team advisor who has already registered for the 3030 MCM/ICM and you would like to register an additional team, go to **Advisor Login** and enter the email address and password that you used when you registered your first team. Once you've logged in to the system you will have an opportunity to register another team.

If you are a team advisor and you have not previously registered a team for this year's MCM/ICM (registration in previous years does not count), enter your email address in the box below and click on the **Continue Registration** button.

Important: There is a \$100 registration fee **for each team** to participate in the MCM/ICM this year, which you will need to pay with a credit card during this online signup process. Please have your credit card ready when you begin the registration process.
